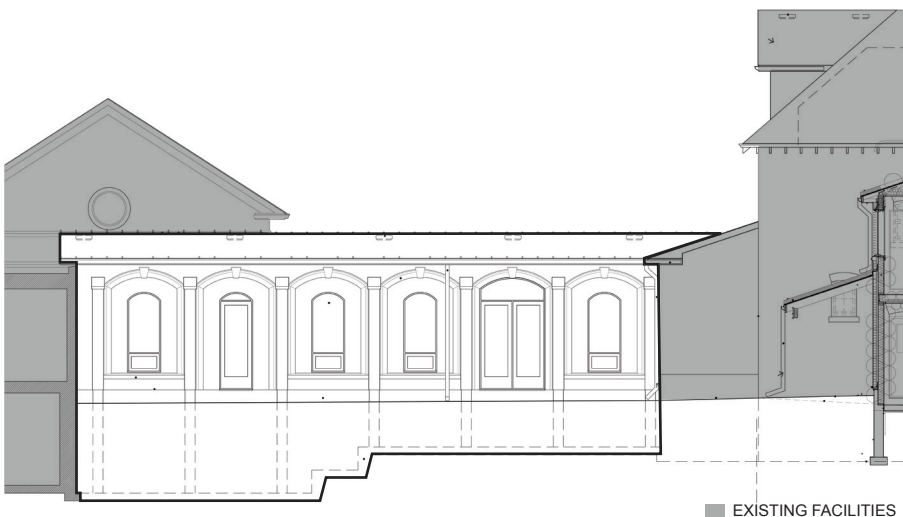


Oratory of St. Philip Neri Toronto, ON



These early twentieth-century brick homes have served as make-shift residences for students of the seminary for several decades. Our task was to seamlessly link the three dwellings to the rest of campus through a fully-glazed sheltered link, which encloses a new contemplation garden. Old interiors were upgraded to adhere to fire and life safety regulations. A new exit stair providing egress from all floors was seamlessly integrated, while the interior ornamental stairs were restored.
