

## High Park Concession

Toronto, ON

Since 2002, the South-East Family Recreation Area of Toronto's High Park has suffered from a lack of washroom facilities and a snack bar after they were demolished by the City to allow for a realignment of a park road. Lapointe Architects proposed a new multi-function concession and washroom pavilion that would include change rooms for a new children's splash pad that would be convertible to an ice rink in the winter. Our Client is currently negotiating leasing terms with the City of Toronto.

## Sunnyside Concession

(Sir Casimir Gzowski Park) Toronto, ON

This proposed multi-purpose facility overlooking the breakwater of Toronto's Western Beaches would replace the existing seasonal concession stand, public washroom and picnic shelter with modern year-round facilities evocative of nautical design. A new children's play area containing a water park and splash pad would be located adjacent to the project's new picnic fabric structure. Our Client is currently negotiating leasing terms with the City of Toronto.
