

Millwood Road Residence

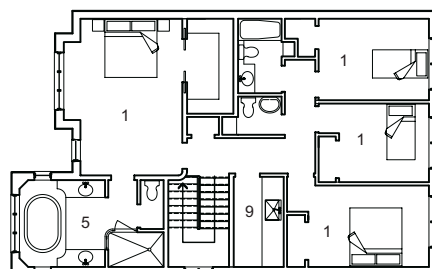
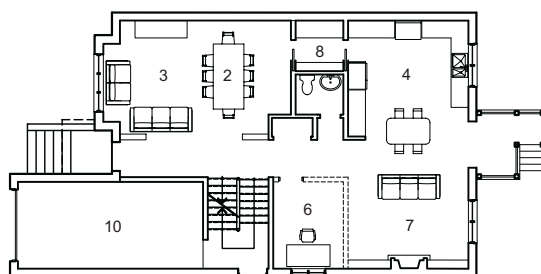
