## The Manse Inn Picton, ON



The building, constructed in 1905, was the manse, or minister's house, for the Picton United Church. The stone and concrete block structure will be completely restored to its former glory. A new wrap-around three-season porch terminates in a new round entrance portico, also serving as a second storey deck, all designed to respect the original architecture. The former bedrooms will be converted into eight guest suites, while the main floor living spaces will be restored to their former grandeur.
