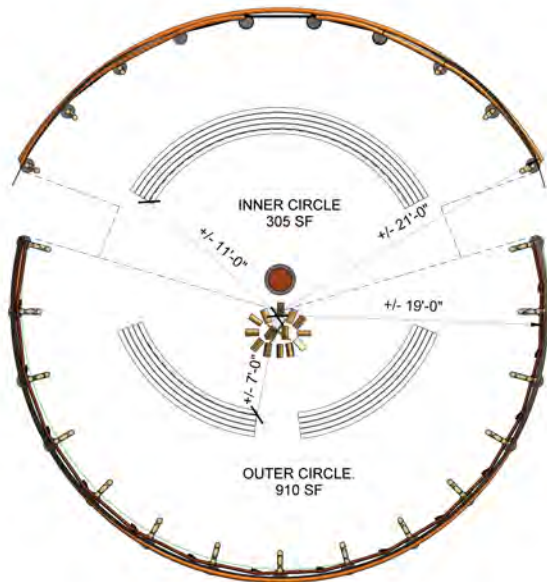


Fire Arbour

Atikameksheng Anishnawbek First Nation



FLOOR PLAN

This 1,200 sq/ft spiritual structure is located on the sacred grounds of the Atikameksheng Anishnawbek First Nation in Northern Ontario. The form is evocative of a traditional bent sapling wigwam, but instead utilizes round logs formed into arched bow trusses. A central opening allows smoke to drift out, while low glazing provides views of the water and mountains beyond. The structure will be clad with rough saw boards and cedar shakes and shingles.

BUDGET \$120,000 plus volunteer labour
