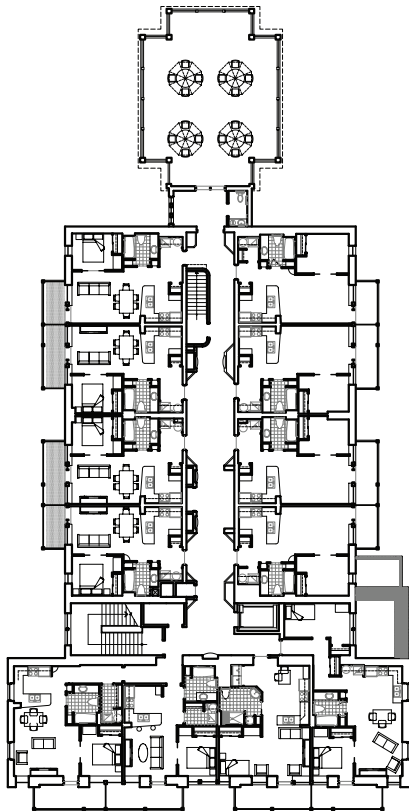
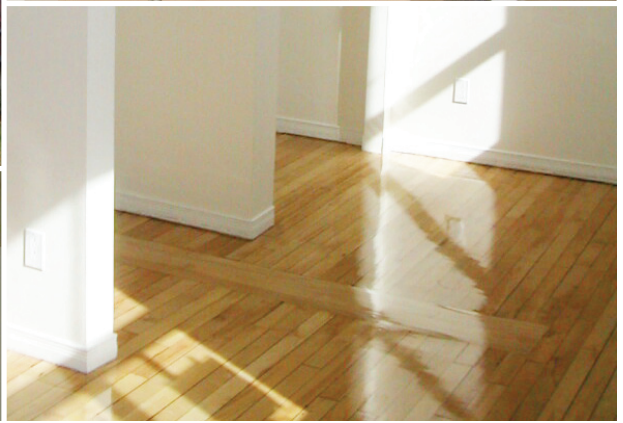


St. George's Ukrainian Seniors' Housing Oshawa, ON



Converting the former South Simcoe Public School into an apartment building for seniors required careful integration of modern construction methods and materials while preserving the original brick masonry and timber structure. The former school was completely gutted to allow for the reinforcement of original structural elements, followed by the installation of new heating, ventilation, plumbing, fire alarms and electrical services. New fire and sound-proof partitions and floors were added as was a new elevator to provide barrier-free access to all floors.
