
High Park Concession Toronto, ON





Since 2002, the South-East Family Recreation Area of Toronto's High Park has suffered from a lack of washroom facilities and a snack bar after they were demolished by the City to allow for a realignment of a park road. Lapointe Architects proposed a new multi-function concession and washroom pavilion that would include change rooms for a new children's splash pad that would be convertible to an ice rink in the winter.
